## How to Measure Your Head for an American Hat Company Hat

Finding the right fit for your cowboy hat is essential for comfort and style.

Follow these simple steps to measure your head and ensure the perfect fit for an American Hat Company hat.

What You'll Need:

 $\checkmark$  A flexible measuring tape (or a piece of string and a ruler)

 $\checkmark$  A mirror or a friend to assist

Step-by-Step Guide:

- Position the Tape
- Place the measuring tape around your head, just above your eyebrows and ears this is where your hat will naturally sit.
- Keep the tape level all the way around your head.
- **2** Find Your Measurement
  - Pull the tape snug but not too tight—you want your hat to be comfortable, not constricting.
  - Read the measurement in inches or centimeters. If using string, mark the spot and measure it against a ruler.
- **3** Match Your Size
  - Use the American Hat Company size chart to find the corresponding hat size. If you're between sizes, go up for a looser fit or down for a snugger feel.
- Size chart found at the bottom of this page.
- **4** Consider Your Fit Preference
- A properly fitted hat should be secure but not squeeze your head. If you're in a hot or humid climate, a slightly looser fit might be more comfortable as your head may swell slightly.

**Pro Tips:** 

Try on different styles—cattleman crowns, open crowns, and brims can affect how a hat fits.

If you're ordering online, double-check your measurements to avoid sizing mistakes.

A professional hat shaper can make minor adjustments to fine-tune the fit. Once you've got your size, it's time to pick the perfect American Hat Company.
